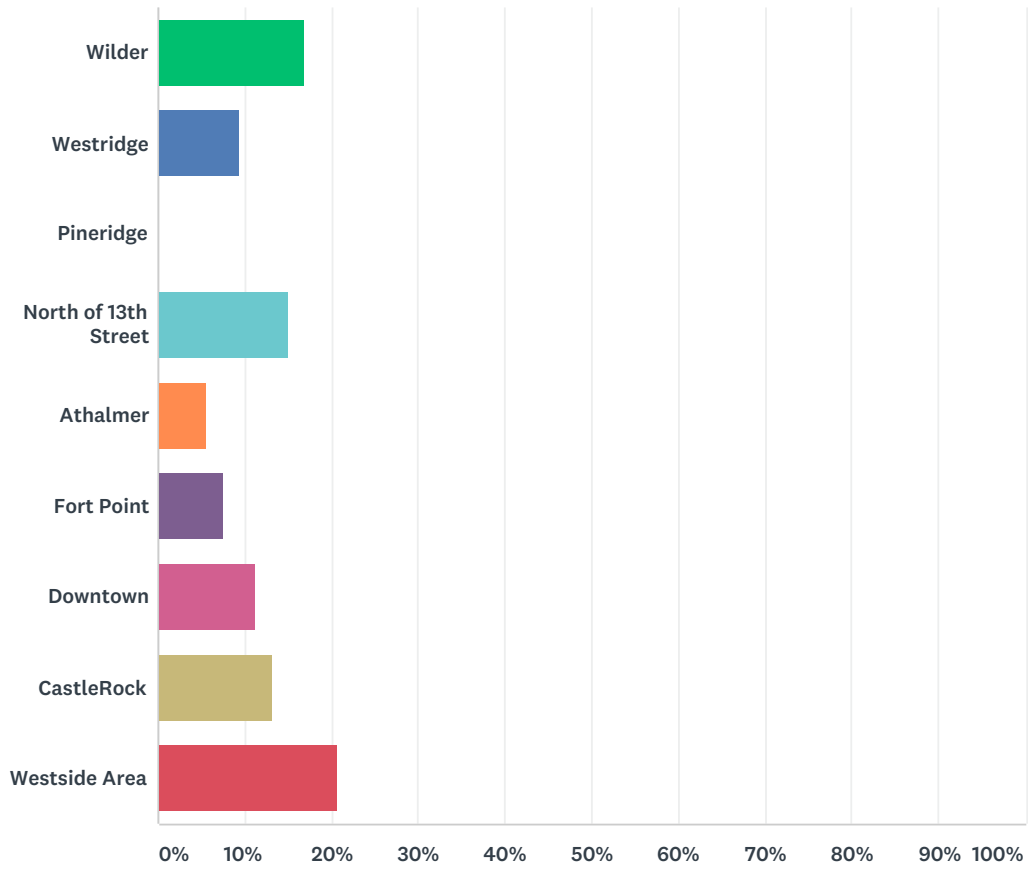


Q1 Which area of Invermere do you live in?

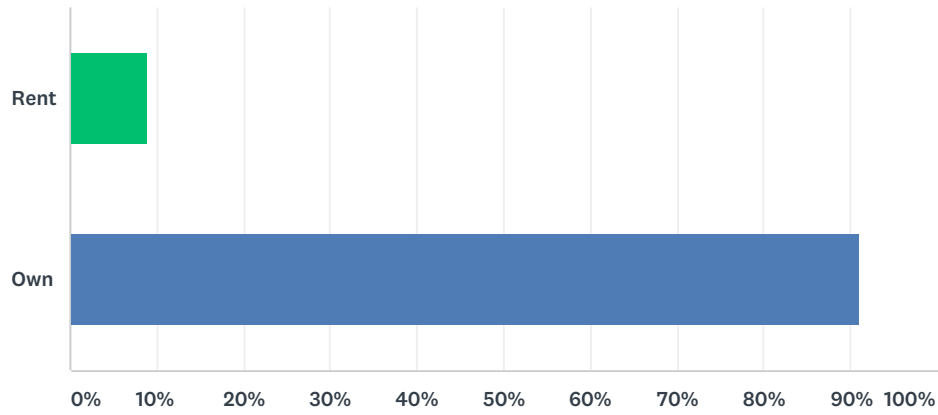

Q2 Do you rent or own your residence?

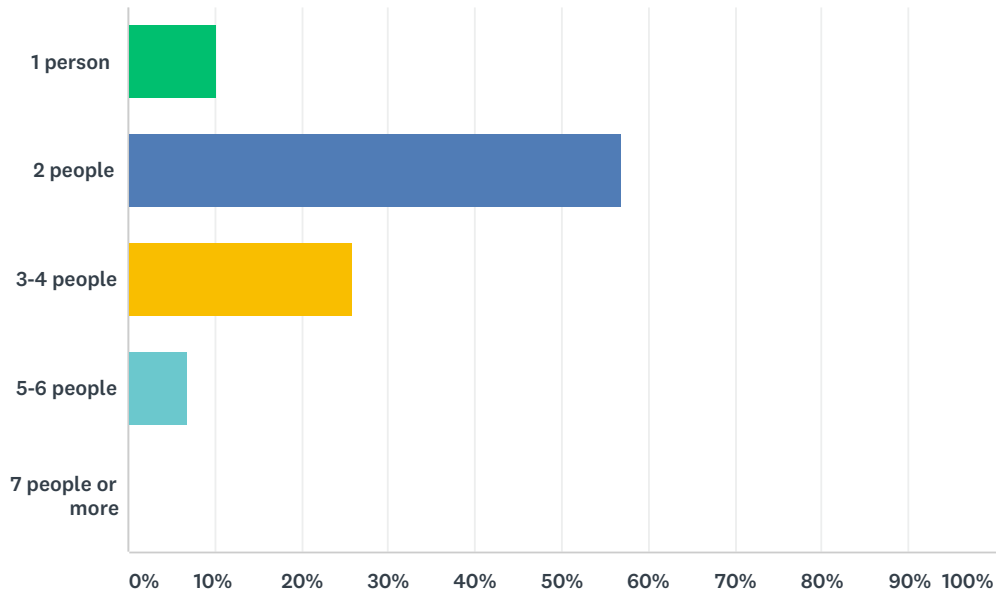

Q3 How many people live in your household?

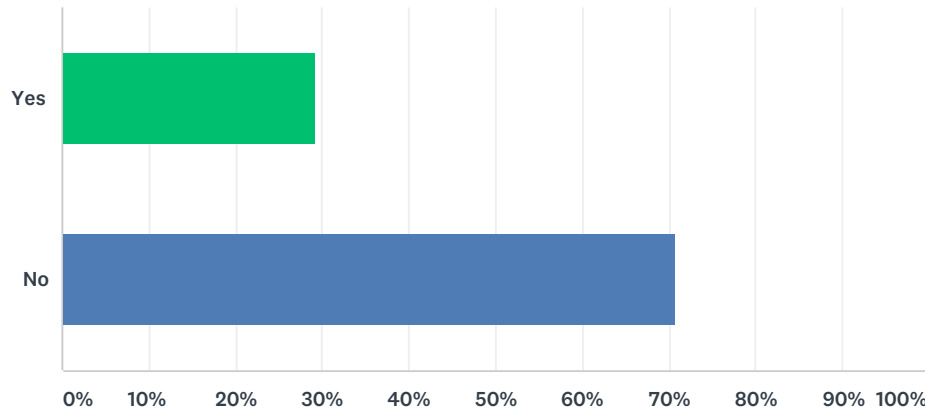

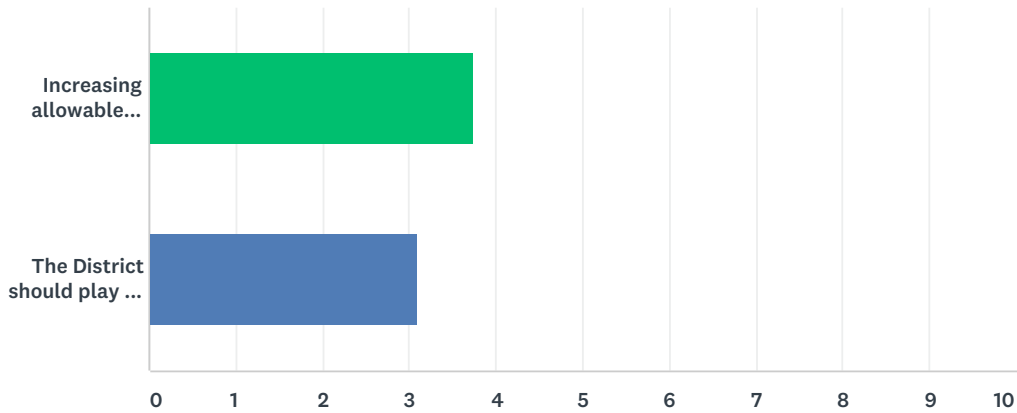

Q8 To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements: (left being "Strongly Disagree" and right being "Strongly Agree")

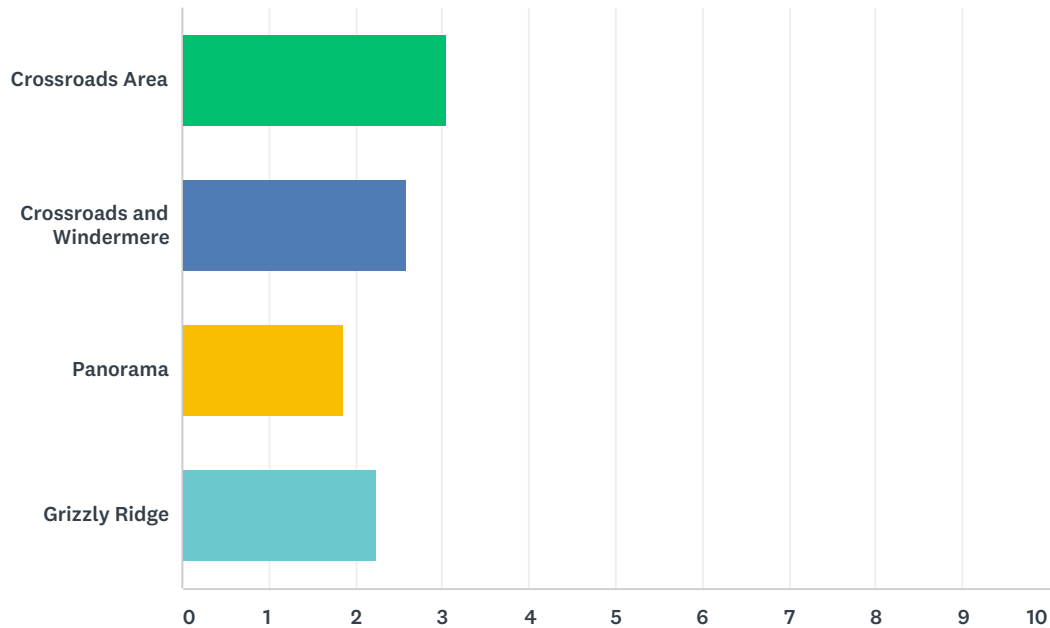

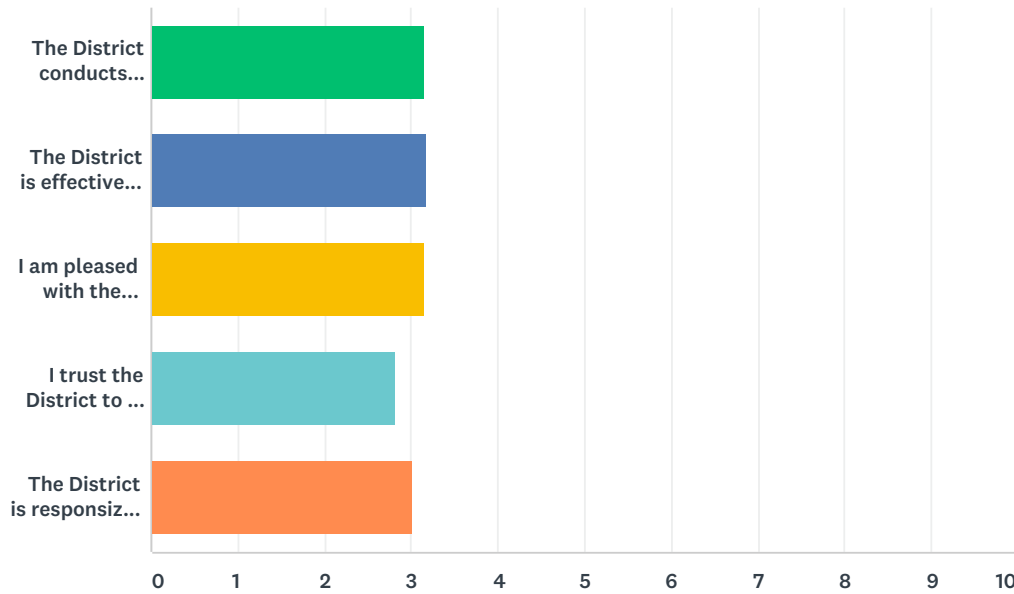

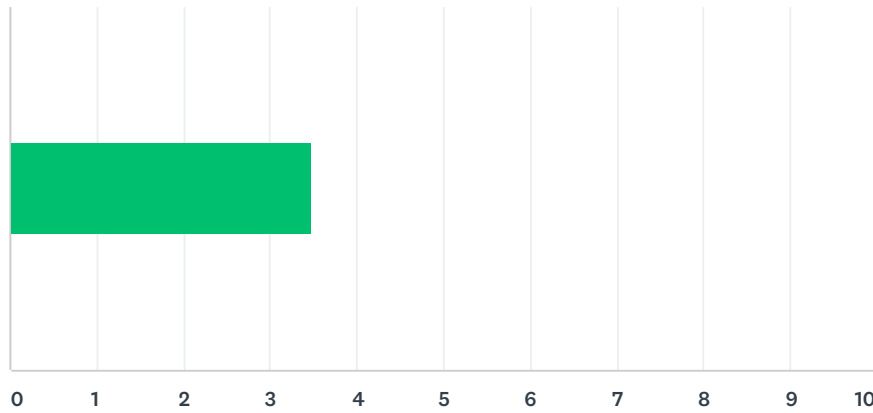

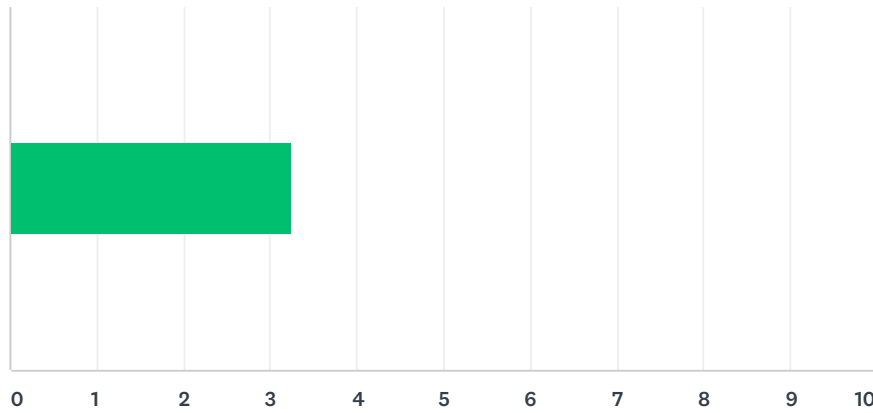

Q14 How would you rate the value you receive for your municipal tax dollars?(1 being "Very Poor" and right being "Excellent")

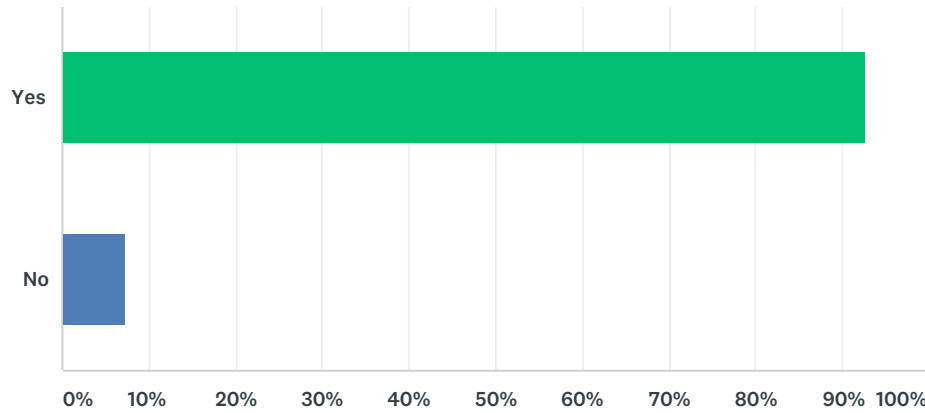

Q15 With the opening of the new Columbia Valley Centre, would you like to see recreation and social programming in the facility?

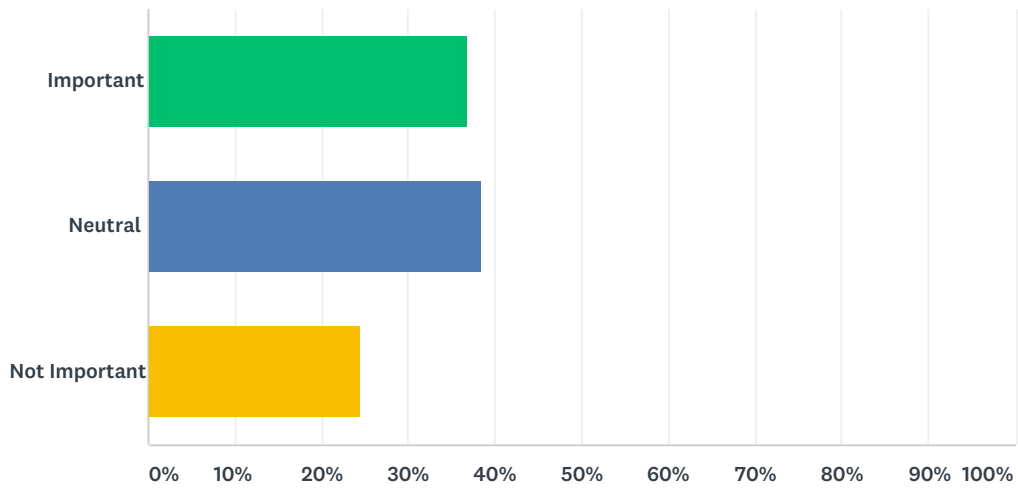

Q16 This year the private sani-dump was removed. Is the presence of a sani-dump within the community important to you?

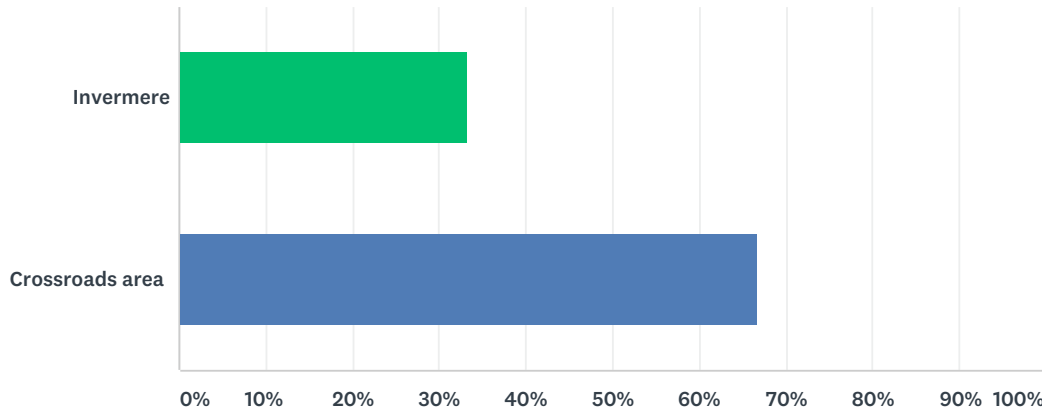

Q17 Do you think the sani-dump should be located in Invermere or near the crossroads area?

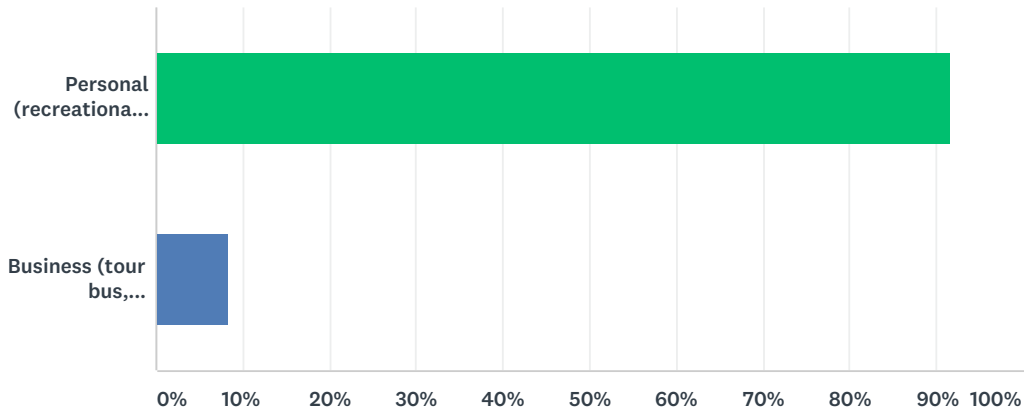

Q18 Do you use the sani-dump for personal or business purposes?

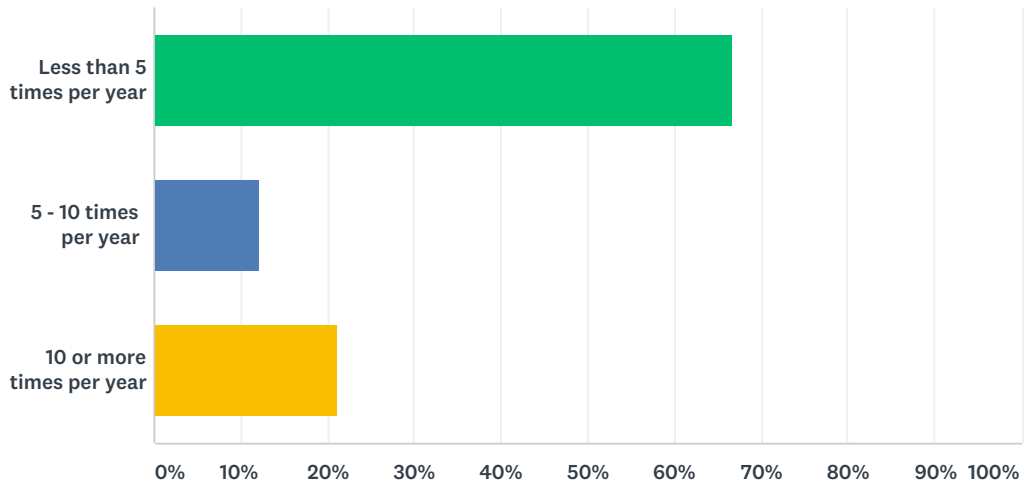

Q19 How often would you use a sani-dump on an annual basis?

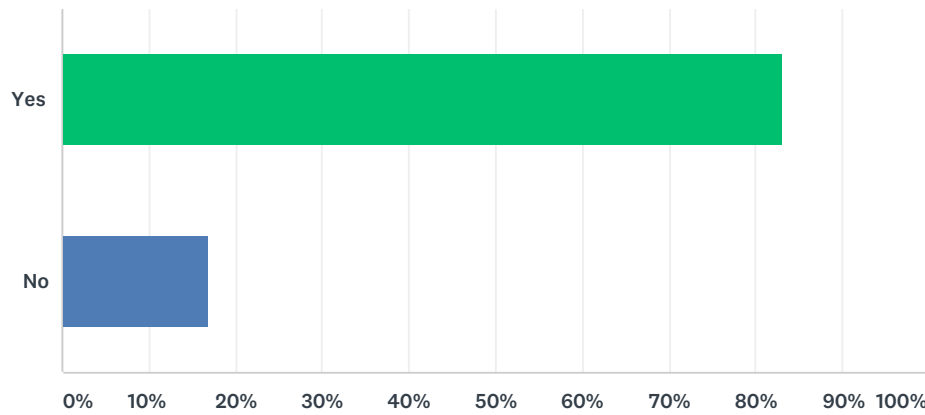

Q20 Would you be prepared to have a user pay system for sani-dump services in the community?

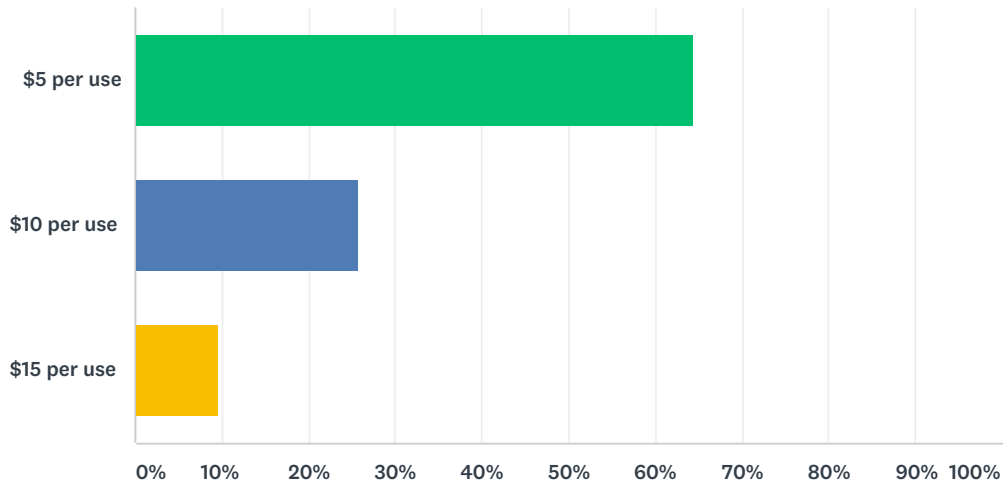

Q21 How much are your prepared to pay for each use of a sani-dump?

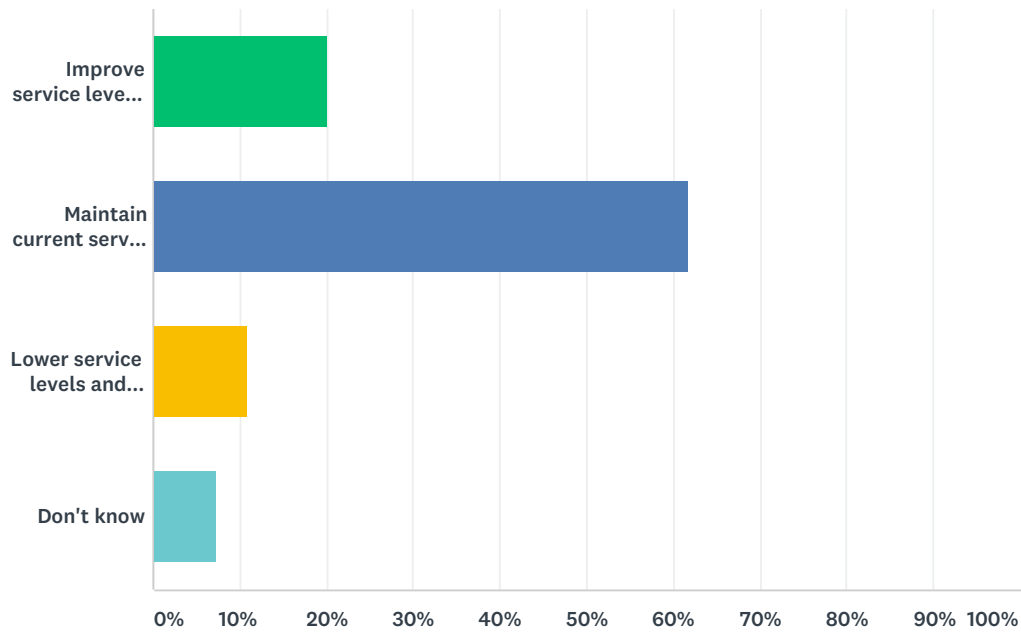

Q22 If you were faced with the following choices, which direction would you want the District to take over the next three years?

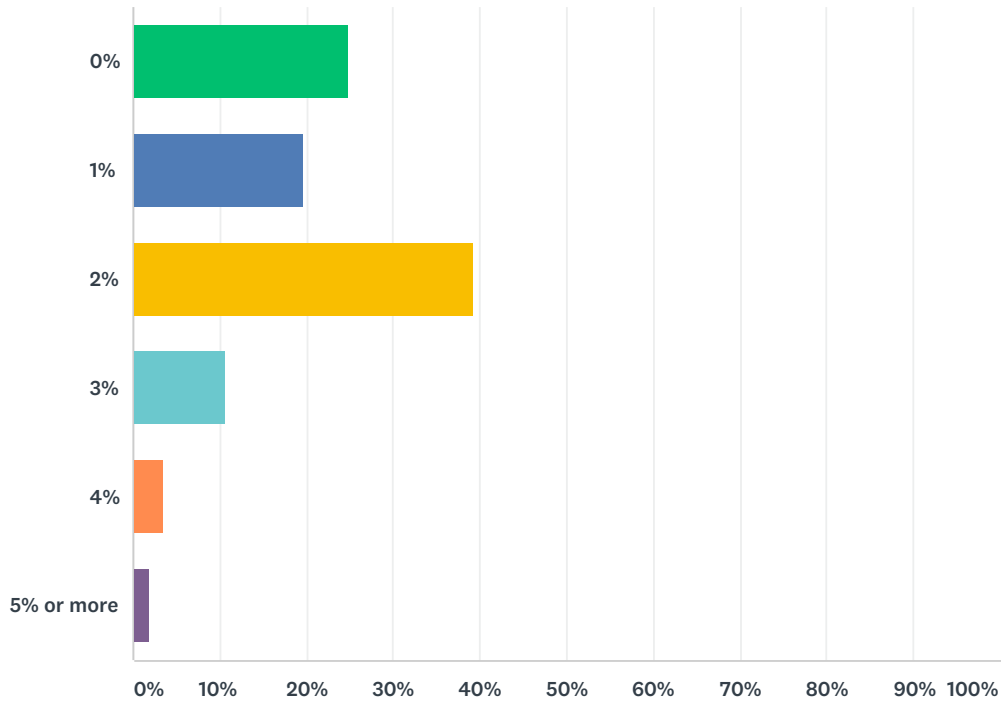

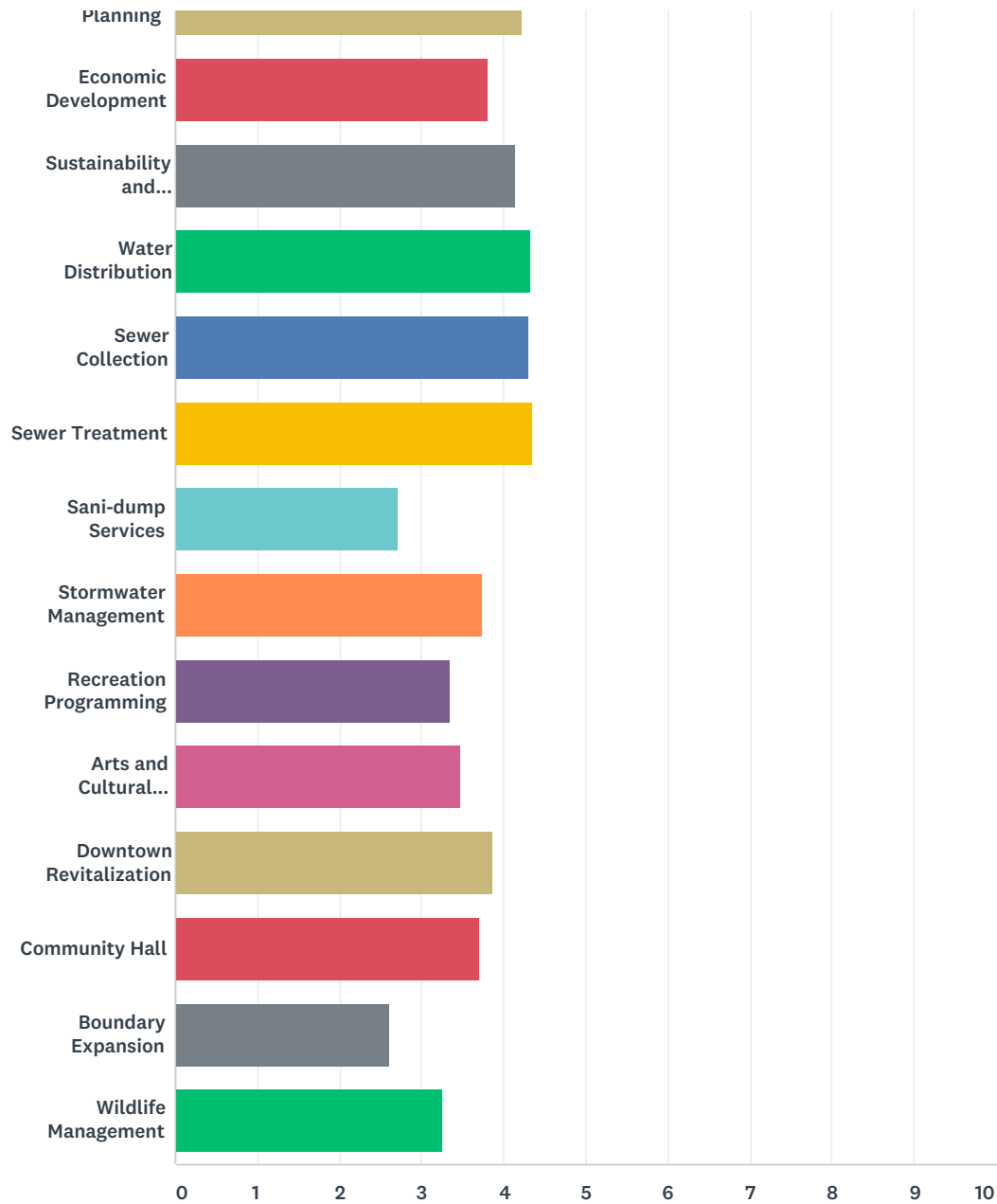

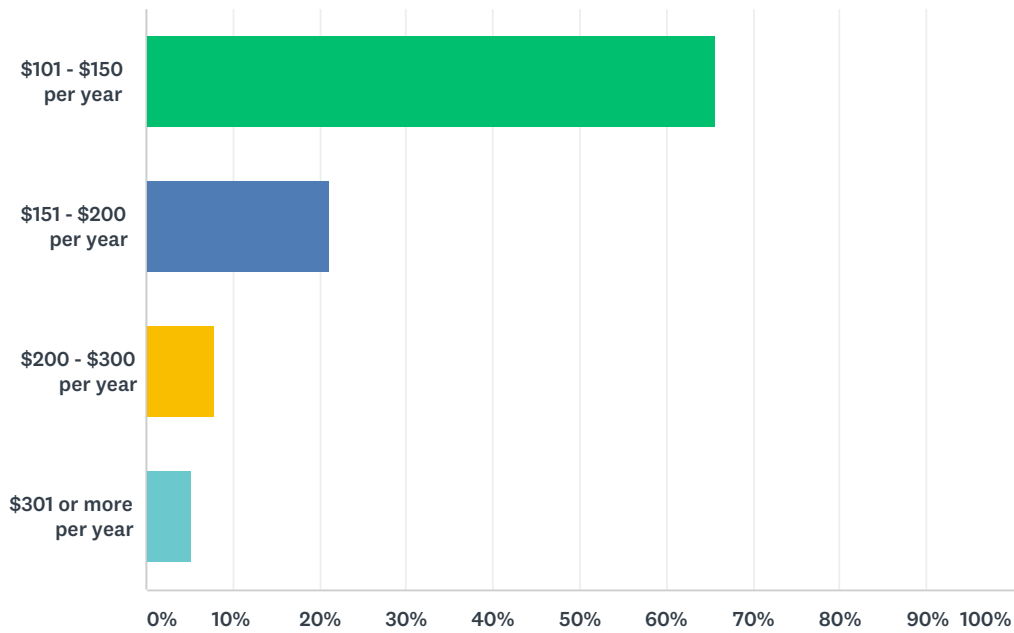

Q27 What level of financial support do you think you could support for future asset replacement?

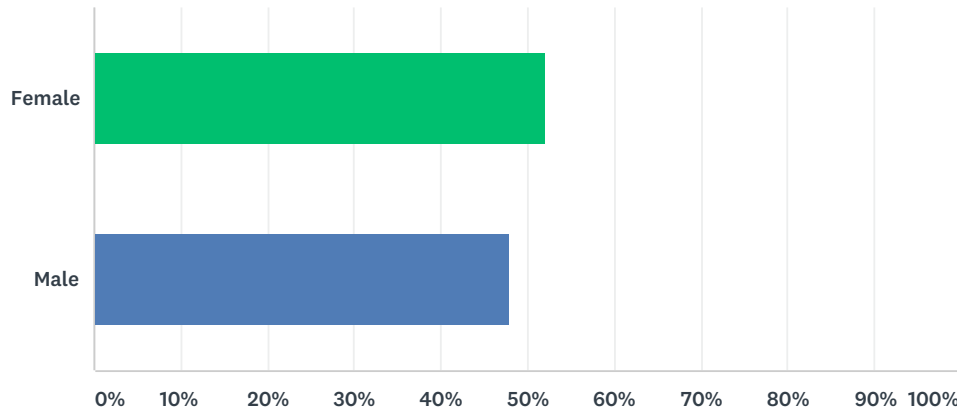

Q28 What is your gender?

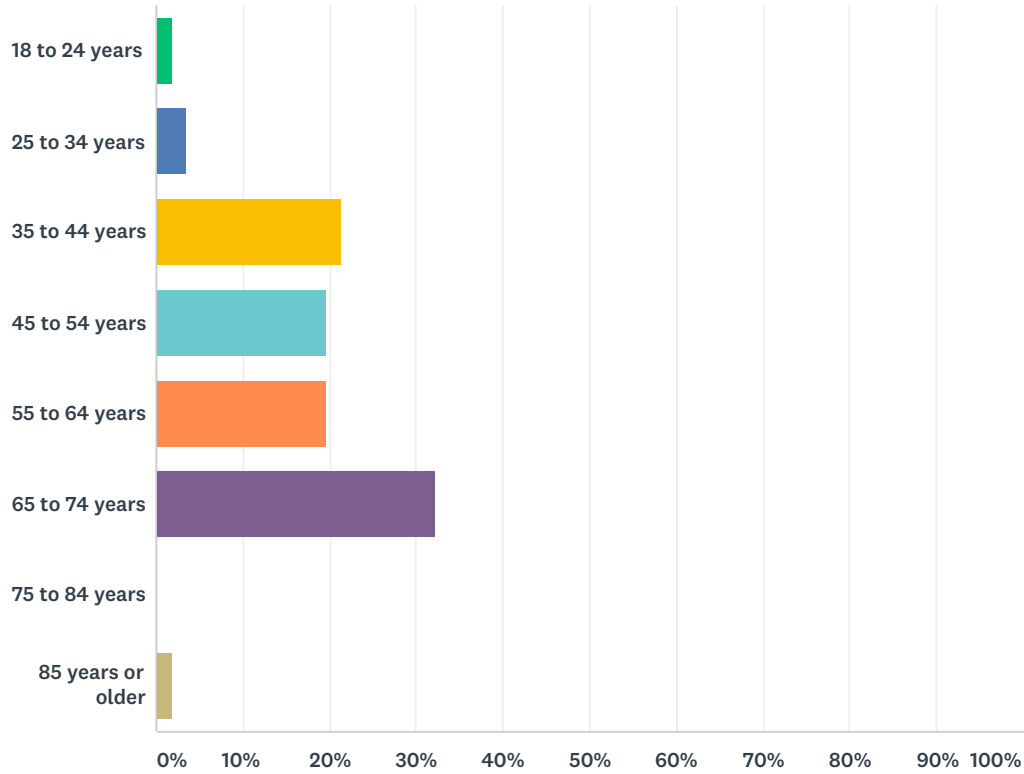

Q29 What age group are you in?

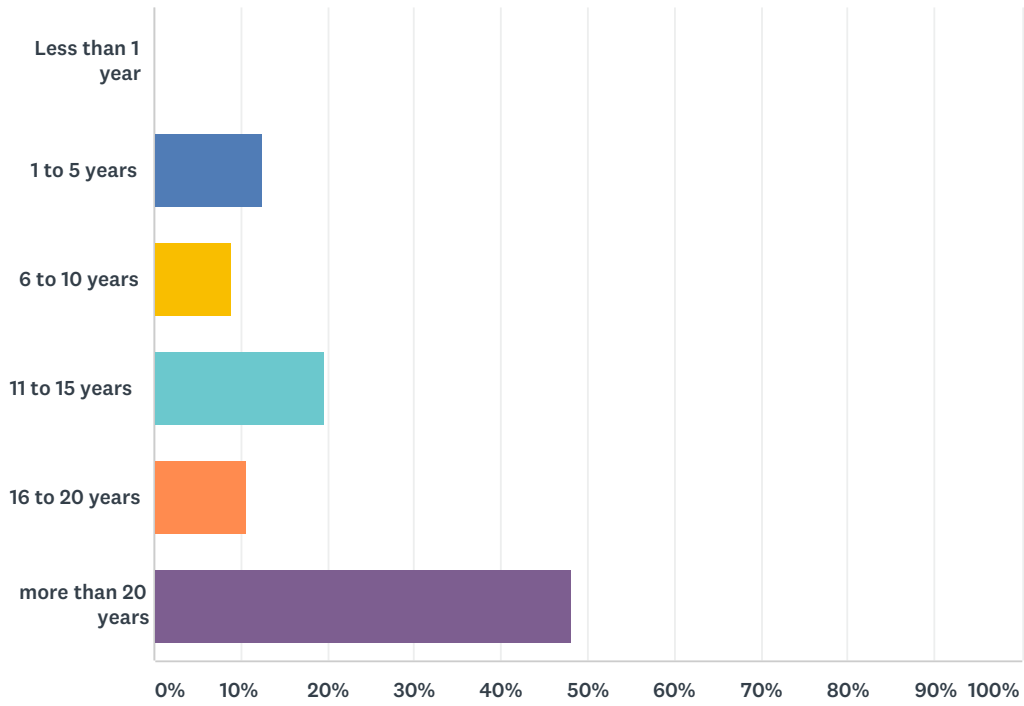

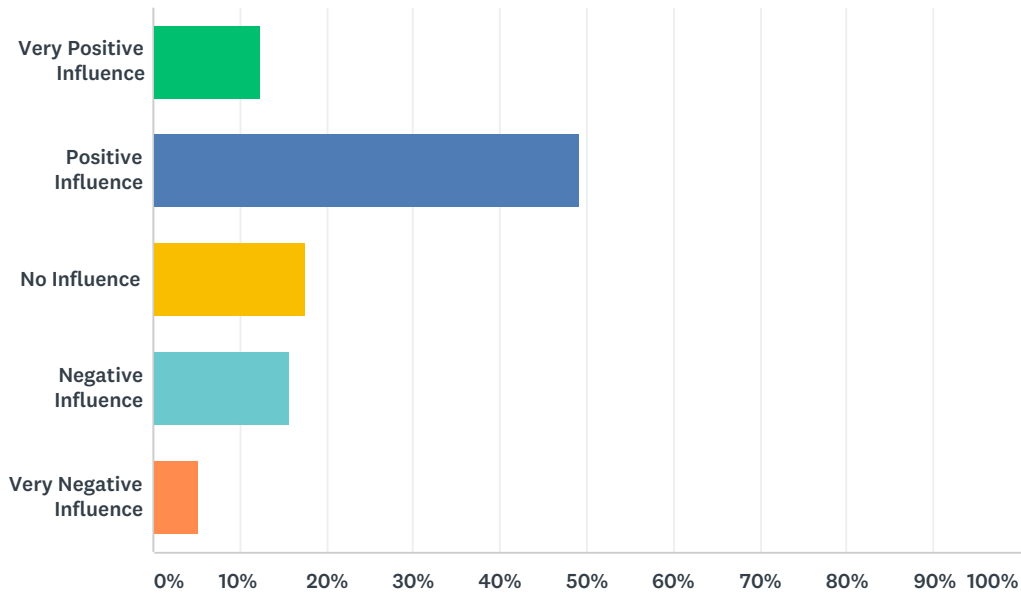
